_____ (B) initiation of litigation or litigation which is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing;

_____ (C) the implementation of security systems; or

_____ (D) the purchase or lease of real property of the governing body up to the time a contract or option to purchase or lease is executed by the parties.

_____ To receive information about, and interview prospective employees.

With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:

_____ (A) to receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and

_____ (B) to discuss, prior to any determination, that individual's status as an employee, student, or independent contractor who is a physician.

 To discuss before any placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior, and needs.

 X To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to any discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.

When considering the appointment of a public official, to:

 (A) develop a list of prospective appointees;

 (B) consider applications; and

 (C) make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.

 To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of their role as public officials.
