Temporary Inter-fund Loan

RELATED INFORMATION: Cash deficits in funds of the corporation are not allowed at the end of a fiscal year. Transfer from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund

Dr. Daniel presented the following recommendation concerning the Transfer from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund:

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve a transfer of up to \$15,000,000 from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund. This represents 7.1% of budgeted Education Fund revenue.

RELATED INFORMATION: Beginning in 2019, Indiana school districts deposit State tuition support to the Education Fund and property taxes to the Operations Fund. Transfers from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund are necessary to properly fund expenditures necessary to the operations of the school district. Half will be transferred by June 30 and the balance needed by December 31.

Chief Financial Officer Kathy Friend was available to answer questions.

RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER AMOUNTS FROM EDUCATION FUND
TO THE OPERATIONS FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees is the governing body of Fort Wayne Community Schools, Allen County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, HEA 1009 required the governing body of each school corporation to establish an Education Fund for the payment of expenses allocated to student instruction and learning under IC 20-42.5, and

WHEREAS, HEA 1009 required the governing body of each school corporation to establish an Operations Fund for the payment of expenses that are not allocated to student instruction and learning under IC 20-42.5, and

WHEREAS, HEA 1009 requires that distributions of tuition support be received in the Education Fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of School Trustees authorizes the Treasurer of Fort Wayne Community Schools to transfer the amount of \$15,000,000 from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund to reimburse the Operations Fund for expenses that are not allocated to student instruction and learning under IC 20-42.5 for the period of 2021.

A motion was made by Rohli Booker, seconded by Maria Norman, that the recommendation concerning the Transfer from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.






