2017-2018 Adult Education Competitive Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the 2017-2018 Adult Education Competitive Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Adult Education Competitive Grant for 2017-2018 in the amount of \$1,005,237.13 from the Indiana Department of Workforce Development, Division of Adult, Career and Technical Education.

RELATED INFORMATION: The 2017-2018 Adult Education Competitive Grant is State funding allocated annually to twelve regions of the State of Indiana. Funds from this grant will allow for the continuation of a range of services for the FWCS District/Allen County Continuing Education Program. The funds in this year's grant are designated for personnel, professional development, instructional materials, supplies, equipment, purchased services, and integrated educational and training. \$888,332.76 of the total \$1,005,237.13 in the 2017-2018 Adult Education Competitive Grant will be used for Adult Education personnel, professional development, instructional materials, supplies, equipment and purchased services and \$116,904.37 of the total grant must be used in developing Integrated Education and Training for all FWCS Continuing Education adult education students, including education, workforce preparation activities, and workforce training.

This competitive grant, is an open grant for the 2017-18 year, and then is continued for three additional years as a closed renewable grant in 2018-19, 2019-20, and 2020-21. The Adult Education Grant supports services for students sixteen years of age and older. The grant is written by Manager of the Continuing Education Department Patrick Boles along with the Region 3 Adult Education Consortium and supports FWCS District Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence* and Goal II: *Engage Parents and the Community*.
