### Who is eligible for pre-K?

Children living in designated school attendance boundaries who will be 4 years old on or before Aug. 1, 2018.

### When are classes offered?

FWCS pre-K students meet with their teachers before the start of the school year. Classroom instruction begins Aug. 27. In our half-day programs, morning classes take place each day from 8:20-10:55 a.m.; afternoon classes are from 12:20-2:55 p.m. In our full-day programs at Adams and Study, students attend from 8:20 a.m.-2:55 p.m.

All Title I pre-K programs are accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children and have earned the Level 4 Paths to Quality rating. Paths to Quality is Indiana's statewide rating system for early care and education programs.
