Scheme #3 - Same as #2 above, except we can remove the top floor of classrooms (6) of the 1912 building and provide new roof.

(a) Total cost of Scheme #2 above \$360,000.00

(b) Savings if top floor of 12,000 sq. ft. is not rehabilitated, top floor is wrecked and new roof provided - deduct 40,000.00

Approximate cost - Scheme #3 \$320,000.00  
(Provides 19 classrooms at approximately \$17,000 per classroom.)

We would like to point out at this time that these estimates are based on past prevailing costs, which will undoubtedly be too conservative after the steel strike is settled, wages in the building industry are raised and other inflationary factors which may take effect. We therefore suggest that a contingency or cushion of between 5% to 10% be added to all estimates as a safety factor."

Richard Fisher, 3rd grade student at Indian Village School, was announced as the winner for naming the Kekionga Junior High School, which was sponsored by the Foster Park Lions Club.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
