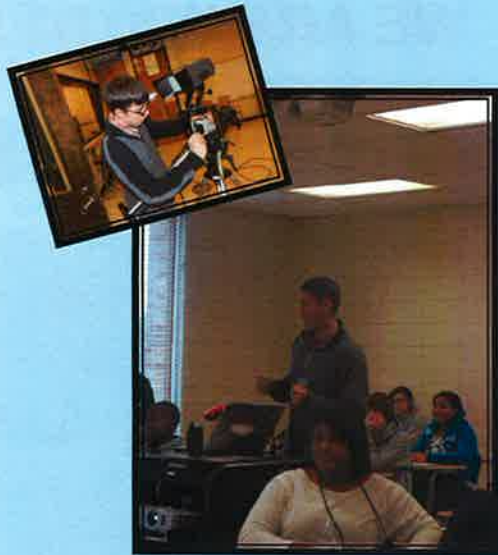


Freshman Block!

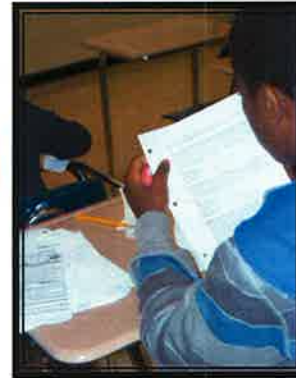
The Freshman Block is a 9th Grade initiative that allows in-coming Freshmen to successfully transition into the academic rigor of high school. All 9th grade students are placed in a cohort group of 25-30 students and they all attend their Math (Algebra I), Science (Biology) and Language Arts (English 9) classes as a Small Learning Community. This "best practice" allows our 9th graders to collaborate with peers in a variety of subject disciplines. Some of our most experienced and dedicated teachers are assigned to the Freshmen Block Program.
