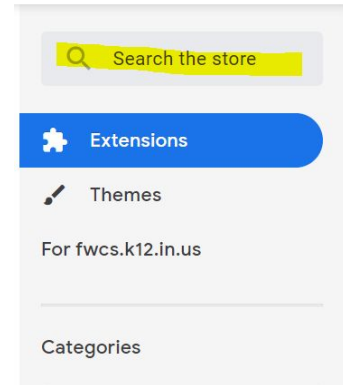
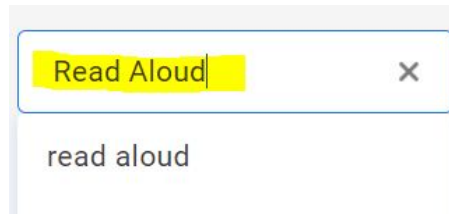



Downloading Extensions From Chrome

Go to [Chrome Extensions](#) or Google Chrome Extensions


In the Search Bar, search the extension you would like to download.
