

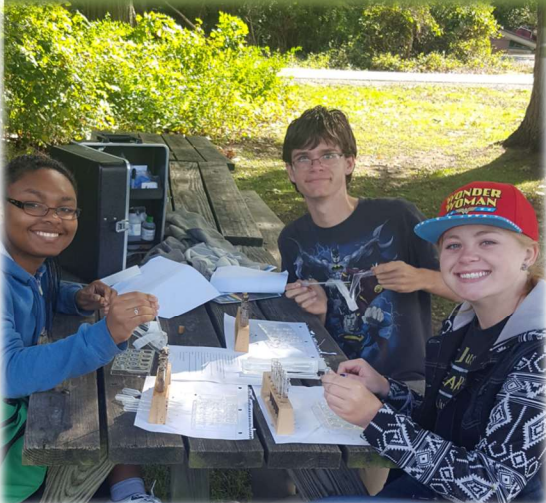

## Program Overview

The International Baccalaureate (IB) program is a rigorous pre-university course of study. The IB program's goals are to provide students with the values and opportunities that will enable them to develop sound judgement, make wise choices and respect others in the global community.

Successful completion of the IB program can result in a diploma that is recognized by many universities in their admissions selection process, course credit, class standing and scholarship eligibility. South Side also offers students the option to take individual IB courses. IB graduates are well prepared for university work, and the IB diploma has earned a reputation for rigorous assessment, giving graduates access to the world's leading universities.

IB Candidates sit will take exams in all six groups, most of which occur during their senior year. These exams and the corresponding scores in the classes can result in college credit.

In addition to the six examinations, students must also satisfactorily complete the following requirements:

- Extended Essay – independent research paper
- Theory of Knowledge – coursework
- CAS – compulsory participation in creativity, action, and service activities.
