



Notice for Immunization for All Student Enrollment

2017-18 School Year

Fort Wayne Community Schools requires the parent/guardian of a child newly enrolled in our school corporation to furnish a written statement of the child's immunization record ***no later than the first day of school.*** This statement should be accompanied by the physician's certificates or other documentations.

The table below indicates the number of doses of vaccine required for each grade level. *Please refer to the column which lists required shots for your child's grade level.*

Note: immunization law frequently changes in July just before the start of school. If changes in the law impact your child's requirements you will be notified by your school nurse and provided a reasonable time period to obtain the necessary immunizations.

* Four doses are acceptable if the fourth dose was administered on or after the child's fourth birthday.

** Four doses of either oral polio vaccine (OPV) or inactivated polio vaccine (IPV) in any combination or three doses of all OPV or all IPV are acceptable if the third dose was administered on or after the child's fourth birthday.

*** A child who has had chickenpox disease is considered immune and does not need the vaccine. A statement indicating the date of the disease and signed by physician is required.

! Only 1 Menactra (meningococcal) vaccine needed if dose #1 is on or after the 16th birthday

R – This shot is recommended but not required at this time. The shot will be REQUIRED in this grade at the start of the 2018-19 school year.

The parent/s or guardian may file a written statement of medical or religious objection annually. Medical objections must be signed by your physician. Forms are available at each school. However, if an objection is made, the Student Health and Physical Record should still be completed and returned to the school.

Physical and Dental examinations are recommended for *all* students beginning school for the first time.
